

How to access your ADAVB CPD records

With the end of the CPD cycle approaching on 30 November 2022, it's important to have up to date CPD records.

ADAVB members can download their ADAVB CPD attendance certificates at adavb.org/members by clicking on 'My CPD Activities'. You'll need your ADAVB password and login to access your member dashboard.

If you have forgotten or need to change your password, go to the member login at adavb.org, enter your email address and click 'forgotten password'. A link will be sent to you to update your password.
